The challenge for each of us is to listen in the midst of all of "life's noise."

Our Chrysalis Community has been so blessed to have such a great group of workers, young and not-so-young alike. But as we are reminded of the plentiful harvest, more workers are needed. It may be sponsoring a young person on a flight, working a flight, volunteering to serve on a committee, serve on the Chrysalis Board, joining in the 72 hour prayer vigil for a flight, to serve at the Saturday evening dinner, help with a Hoot, to give agape or snacks for a flight, participate in candlelight, and the list goes on.

It is really the prayer of the Board that many more people from within our Chrysalis Community become involved.

In closing, I wish to thank Doug Mager for all of his service as the previous Community Lay Director. He has been a great mentor for me as well as countless others; and has certainly laid some solid foundations for us to continue to build upon. I also thank all the others who have provided me with encouragement and much needed wisdom.

As we are all here to serve, I encourage everyone in our Community to express their ideas, concerns, and opinions; and certainly participate.

What is sponsorship?

Each young person who attends Chrysalis has a "sponsor" who supports and encourages him/her before, during, and after the Chrysalis experience.

Sponsorship is the way in which the Chrysalis experience is passed on from person to person, reflecting the manner in which God purposefully reaches out to people through other people. After a Chrysalis Weekend, participants want to share the gift of those three days with others. Sponsorship provides them a caring and disciplined way for them to share. And in doing so, sponsors participate in and demonstrate God's outreaching love.

Sponsorship is taken for granted in many communities. The assumption is that everyone knows the how and why of sponsorship. Sometimes sponsorship is only discussed with reference to the number of participants signed up for a Chrysalis Weekend.

Sponsorship, however, is the most important job in the Chrysalis Movement. It is a job shared by the adults who have been through Emmaus and the young people who have been through Chrysalis. It is more than simply "signing youth up." The importance of a Chrysalis Community being educated about good sponsorship cannot be overemphasized. The quality of sponsorship impacts the new participants, the health of the Chrysalis Movement in an area, and the churches being affected by Chrysalis.

We have sponsorship training before each Hoot.

So if you are new to sponsoring, please try to attend the next sponsorship training at 5pm, December 13th at Union United Methodist Church, Brazil.


