Kairos Prison Ministry is the Walk to Emmaus for Prisons.

Weekend #5 is scheduled for Oct 21-24. Rockville CF #12 for women is May 13-16.

Each weekend needs prayer, team members from Emmaus, LOTS of chocolate chip cookies (using ONLY the Kairos recipe), posters, placemats (especially from children), handwritten letters to each participant, and financial donations (there are no team fees and it costs over \$10,000 per week-end). You are encouraged to attend the closing ceremonies, which also substitutes as Candlelight, but you must pre-register 2 weeks in advance.
