"He is not here...He has risen!"

Greetings to all of you in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ! What a great time in history to be a Christian! I know that sounds very presumptuous, since these are the most difficult times in memory. But because these are the most trying and difficult times, it gives us a greater resolve and greater opportunity to share the Lord than ever before. I have found that the enemy doesn't want us to be effective. Have you noticed it too? If we aren't careful, we can easily give the enemy what he wants, rather than giving God what He wants, As I was reading my devotions the other day, I came across the story of the resurrection in Luke 24. I noticed a valuable truth in this particular passage: "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, He has risen!" (Luke 24:5b-6 NIV) I thought that was a great question. Why would we look for the living among the dead? I realize that this might be a stretch in interpreting the meaning of the passage, but I was wondering if it was possible that we look for the Fruits of the Spirit in places where they cannot be found? Fruits like love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control...against these (the Bible says), there is no law. If we really want to emulate and exude these fruits, we will never find them by looking anywhere but heavenward. It is so easy to become distracted or depressed when our eyes are fixated on ourselves, other people, our situations, or even the times in which we live. The Lord gave us a resounding command, and a revealing truth: ""Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me.' 'If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. He who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me." (John 14:1; 23-24 NIV) I hope we are all obeying the Lord's teaching...this means we love Him. You see, the Lord wants to live in us. For this to happen, we must first desire it, and then accept his residence within us. The Apostle Paul taught: "Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things." (Colossians 3:2 NIV) This means we must always be thinking on the things of Christ and His Kingdom. When we focus on earthly things (including self-centeredness!), we are really looking for the living among the dead. Jesus is risen! He has won victory over death and Hades! This means the enemy really has no power over us in Christ Jesus. During this Easter Season, would we allow the Lord to challenge us to look for Him more than we have? Could we focus on the things of Heaven more than we have before? Remember that Jesus said that when we seek, we will find. I pray you will find the Lord, and find Him to the fullest. I wish God's richest and most plentiful blessings on all of you, today and always!

SPONSORSHIP

The following is from the upper room regarding sponsorship. Please be responsible when sponsoring a pilgrim...they deserve the same weekend you experienced and if they are worried about things at home, they can not relax and let the Lord work through them and in them.

Sponsorship. Those working on the team may not sponsor pilgrims on that particular walk. Sponsors need to be free to come and go from the campground so that they can complete their obligations as the sponsor both at the camp and at home.

Sponsorship is an act of love for God, for the participants in the Walk to Emmaus, for the Emmaus Community, and for the church. It is a demonstration of agape love.

A sponsor will: Pray for the participant's openness to God's call to discipleship. Make an appointment with the participant (or participating couple) to discuss his or her participation in Emmaus. Invite the participant to take part in Emmaus for the sake of a more vital relationship with Jesus Christ.

The sponsor shares his or her faith, explains the basic purpose, elements, and follow-up dimensions of the Walk. Ask the participant to make a commitment by filling out a registration form. If the participant is married, the sponsor will speak with both partners and encourage an equal commitment by both spouses. Support the participant's Walk through prayers and otherwise. The sponsor will also support the participant's family by house-sitting, baby-sitting, watering plants, picking up mail, feeding pets, or just checking in with a spouse to see if any help or support is needed. Encourage the participant in his/her continued journey and take the participant to Emmaus "gatherings" after the Walk weekend is over.

Help the participant re-enter his or her church and consider ways to act out new commitment and enthusiasm.

Help the participant sponsor others.


